It is Apex's main intention to give athletes the means to compete at the highest level allowable by each individual and their parents/guardians allow. Playing time is decided by each teams' coach, and is based on: attitude, skill, practice attendance and position.

- Missing practice before a tournament

\*If you do lose a piece of equipment, your parent/guardian will have to purchase a new one. If it is part of your uniform you will not be able to compete until you have your full uniform.

I understand that the fees have been decided based on the number of athletes on my daughter's team. If I choose to quit, then I am responsible for all club fees including end of season tournament fees. I understand if I choose to pull my daughter from Apex, I will not be given a refund for the season. I will always do my best to have my daughter to practices and tournaments on time. I will always respect my daughter's coach and her teammates.

- I will never question my daughter's playing time at a tournament
- I will give the coach the respect of waiting 24 hours after a tournament or practice BEFORE requesting a meeting to discuss any issues
- If I do question my daughter's playing time or a decision made by the coach, I will schedule an appointment with the coach and the club director.
- Initial contact should be made in person or by phone, not by email
- Any final decisions made by the club director will remain final and not subject to appeals

It is unacceptable to disrespect anything from Apex, and if you do so it will be addressed immediately. Apex holds the right to dismiss any player or parent at any time for reasons they think are necessary. It is very important that you are on board with the decisions made for your daughter. These decisions have your daughter and her team's best interest in mind. Apex is here to help your daughter and her volleyball goals in the future. Please believe that we will do our best to help achieve those goals.
